

Summary of Town Hall Meeting 8-30-2018

3. Paige Peterson (Finance Director at Navajo County), reviewed how the County determines the District Budget each year. Paige Presented the budget for this fiscal year and the three years prior and answered the questions of those in attendance
4. The docks: 2 members of the community (Mark Knoell & Thomas Aisenbrey) assisted in locating and contacting companies to get quotes on fixing/restructuring the docks. While the Administration has received quotes to fix/restructure the docks, the budget won't support the restructuring of the current dock system and more floats need to be purchased to better stabilize the docks. The floats on the rental dock were repaired and it was determined that beavers had damaged them. Thanks were given to Monty Montgomery for diving in the lake, locating the concrete anchors for the fishing and rental docks, and reporting on the status of the cables. The fishing dock has broken loose of its anchor; the anchor cables are rusted and need to be replaced. That dock is currently held in place by a temporary anchor and guide lines. Thanks were given to John Hager for using his boat to assist in pulling the dock back into position so staff could put the temporary anchor in place and Monty Montgomery could attach the guide lines. The administration will continue to review the quotes received as well as suggestions from the community to decide on the best course of action moving forward.
5. There will be a ribbon cutting ceremony at Carr Circle to officially open the playground to the community. This is scheduled to take place on Saturday, September 8, at 11:00 AM. There is a community meeting that same day at 9:00 AM at the Post Office and everyone is encouraged to attend that meeting.
