We are working with county representatives to set up a food assistance (and other needs) program here in WML. We are working to partner with them on communication, processes, and procedures we will need to coordinate and execute this type of program.

We are building a set of databases to help with the coordination efforts to ensure the people in WML have their needs met.

We are building a Volunteer database. We need young healthy volunteers that can help with:

1. Food donation receipt, cleaning, and organization
2. Food and/or supply purchases
3. Food and/or supply delivery
4. Communication - building email and phone database for communicating with the community what assistance is available.

We are building a "needs assistance" database to track those requesting aid. Information we will need if you are requesting aid for yourself or others:

1. Family Last Name
2. Physical Address
3. Phone Number
4. Email Address
5. Number of people in household
6. Household member names and ages
7. Whether elderly in the home
8. Comments/Special needs

We will start taking non-perishable food donations and household supply donations at the community center. Donation boxes will be placed outside the building, under the covered porch starting Monday. Cash donations can be coordinated through Jessica (secretary.wmlca@gmail.com).
