

HB2067 -- WM2CRID Local Board

White Mountain Lakes County Recreation Improvement District Implementation Update

July 28, 2022

General Effective Date: September 24, 2022

Anticipated Timeline

August 2022: Board member application and selection criteria developed.

Navajo County will develop the initial White Mountain Lakes County Recreation Improvement District Board Member Application and selection criteria. It is anticipated there will be requirements for who can serve on the board, which will be different than who can vote in board elections. Once that information is clarified, it will be included with the application materials and in subsequent updates.

Late September 2022: Board member applications and selection criteria finalized.

October 2022: The Navajo County Board of Supervisors establishes the White Mountain Lakes County Recreation Improvement District and board member applications become available.

The Navajo County Board of Supervisors must hold a public hearing and pass a resolution to officially establish the White Mountain Lakes County Recreation Improvement District. No official action related to this new district can be taken prior to the general effective date. After the Board of Supervisors has established the new governance structure for the district, board member applications will be made available.

Late October 2022: Board member applications reviewed.

Late October/Early November 2022: Navajo County Board of Supervisors appoints initial White Mountain Lakes County Recreation Improvement District Board of Directors.

The Navajo County Board of Supervisors must determine the total number, 3 or 5 members, that will make up the White Mountain Lakes County Recreation Improvement District's Board of Directors. The Board of Supervisors will also officially appoint the requisite number of board members based on the pool of qualified electors submitting applications.

January 2023: White Mountain Lakes County Recreation Improvement District holds inaugural board of directors meeting.
