HB206 PASSED - - LOCAL DISTRICT BOARD

On March 30, the Governor signed HB2067, a law that changes how the White Mountain Lakes County Recreation Improvement District (WMLCRID) will operate. Previously (since 1993), the Navajo County Board of Supervisors has served has the Governing Board for the WMLCRID. Now, after a transition period, the District will be governed by Board of Local Community Members. This Board will be first appointed, then elected, & will live within the District's boundaries. Special thanks goes out to the Navajo County Staff & Supervisor Whiting who have done a tremendous job of pushing forward this change to the AZ Statute.
